Osteopaths Board of Qld Chair joins national board



The Osteopaths Board of Queensland extended its congratulations to Dr Natalie Rutsche who was appointed as practitioner member from Queensland to the Osteopathy Board of Australia.

The Australian Health Workforce Ministerial Council announced the appointment of 108 inaugural members of ten national boards for the new National Registration and Accreditation Scheme for the Health Professions which commences on 1 July 2010.

Dr Rutsche is one of 72 practitioner members to join a national Board and one of 39 members currently chairing a State and Territory Board.

She joined the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Registration Board of Queensland in 2001 and has operated her own osteopathic clinic in Brisbane since that time.

She has been a member of the Osteopaths Board of Queensland since 2002 and was appointed as Chair in April 2006.
